Proposed Change to Chesterfield County Curbside Recycling

Central Virginia Waste Management Authority (CVWMA) and Chesterfield County announce a proposed change in curbside recycling collection for Chesterfield curbside recycling participants **ONLY**. On April 15, 2009 the Chesterfield Board of Supervisors will consider a recommendation to reduce recycling collection from bi-weekly to once every 4 weeks, effective July 6, 2009. Detailed information will be provided to customers prior to July if the change is approved.

Recycling collection in Goochland, Hanover, Henrico and Richmond will remain on a bi-weekly schedule. Ashland and Colonial Heights will continue to be collected weekly.

The CVWMA and member jurisdictions (Ashland, Charles City, Chesterfield, Colonial Heights, Goochland, Hanover, Henrico, Hopewell, New Kent, Petersburg, Powhatan, Prince George and Richmond) are committed to recycling. Nearly 34,000 tons of paper, cans & bottles were recycled through CVWMA's curbside recycling program last year. Make Every Day Earth Day... Reduce...Reuse...RECYCLE.
