## Recycle these items

### Standard Recyclables at All Locations

- **Cardboard** – packing boxes, cereal and dry food boxes, flattened
- **Newspaper** and glossy inserts
- **Mail, catalogs and magazines**
- **Office and copy paper**
- **Telephone books**
- **Aluminum cans, foil and steel cans**
- **Narrow neck plastic bottles with a 1 or 2**, such as plastic soda and water bottles, milk and juice jugs, and shampoo and detergent bottles, no lids or caps
- **Glass jars and bottles** of any color, no lids or caps

### Specialty Recyclables at East Richmond Road AND/OR Southside Transfer Station

- **Antifreeze, oil and oil filters** (E. Rich. Rd. ONLY)
- **Appliances and scrap metals**
- **Batteries** – lead acid (E. Rich. Rd. ONLY)
- **Electronics** (at special events ONLY)
- **Paints and solvents** (E. Rich. Rd. ONLY)
- **Propane tanks** (E. Rich. Rd. ONLY)
- **Tires** (fees may apply)
- **Yard Waste**
