Items accepted at the events include televisions, computers, computer monitors, computer accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.), printers, scanners, copiers, fax machines, telephones and cell phones, VCRs and camcorders, stereos, microwaves and more. A \$7.00 fee is charged to recycle all televisions but other electronic devices will be collected at no charge. Payment is accepted in cash or by check.
