Recycle anything with a plug! Items accepted at the events include televisions, computers, computer monitors, computer accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.), printers, scanners, copiers, fax machines, telephones and cell phones, VCRs and camcorders, stereos, microwaves and more. A \$7 fee is charged to recycle televisions but other devices will be collected at no charge. Payment is accepted in cash or by check.

In addition to these special weekend collections this **fall**, items may also be brought to several area permanent drop-off locations throughout the year.
