Citizens can recycle unwanted electronic items at several events this fall. The events will be held:

Includes *Prescription Drug Take Backs and *Document Shredding (Up to 4 boxes (10”x 12” x 18” accepted for shredding. (Check with Hanover County for fees, if applicable). (*Hanover residents only.)

Items accepted at the events include televisions, computers, computer monitors, computer accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.), printers, scanners, copiers, fax machines, telephones and cell phones, VCRs and camcorders, stereos, microwaves and more. A \$7 fee is charged to recycle televisions but other devices will be collected at no charge. Payment is accepted in cash or by check.

In addition to these special weekend collections this **fall**, items may also be brought to several area permanent drop-off locations throughout the year.
