Computer systems (hard drive, CPU, monitor) and TVs with \$10 fee for old TVs. Computer accessories (cables, wires, keyboards, mice, speakers, etc.). Printers, scanners, copiers and fax machines. VCRs, camcorders, stereos and all phones.

Pesticides and Herbicides

Let's keep these out of our groundwater, streams and rivers. Bring pesticides (insecticides and rodent poisons) and herbicides (weed killers) for proper disposal.

Small Recycle Tubs

Clean up and drop off your old curbside recycling bins for reuse in the schools.
