Shredding and the Collection of Pesticides, Herbicides and Oil-Based Paints

Document Shredding

- Up to five (5) boxes of documents. Be sure to remove all binders, staples and/or clips.

Biodegradable Bags Give-away

- City residents will be given up to 10 bags for leaf disposal *while supplies last.*

Recycle Bins

- Clean up and drop off your small curbside recycle bin for reuse in the schools

Electronics recycling will **NOT** be collected at this event.

This free event is only available for City of Richmond residents - proof of residency is required.

Pesticides, Herbicides and Oil-based Paints

Help keep these hazardous waste materials out of our Richmond waterways, streams and rivers. Please bring them to us for proper disposal.

- Bug spray, rodent poison and herbicides (roundup, Weed B Gon etc.)

Note: Latex and water-based paints will **NOT** be collected. They can be left in open cans until they have dried out and then put in with regular curbside trash pick-up.
